When looking for a name for this pattern I knew I wanted it to be related with sheep, but my inspiration wasn't working with me. I share my fiber study with my mum, a painter, crocheter and jack of all trades and I asked her for a name related with sheep. She suggested Bolingua.

Bolingua is a "baserri" a basque farm, located just in front of my parents house. It has a field where their sheep roam free nearly all days. They were the first sheep I ever saw when I was a child, my first sheep! So the name fits quite nicely.

Yarn and Needles: 1 skein Ardilanak SuperChunky, 130ms/200gr, 12mm needles.

Notions: K (Knit), P Purl), K2tog (Knit two sts together), SSK (slip 2 stitches, put back on left needle, k2tog), Yo (Yarn Over),
